

- **Approval** on new wells at Horse Hill site
- **OGA approves** go ahead to extract oil from Brockham Site
- Angus Energy completes production oil well at Lidsey near Bognor Regis
- **Link : Surrey Council defer Europa's traffic plan for Bury Hill Wood** but approve fencing plan. You can see the whole meeting on video link above.
- **Cuadrilla apply** to test flow Balcombe oil well in West Sussex.
